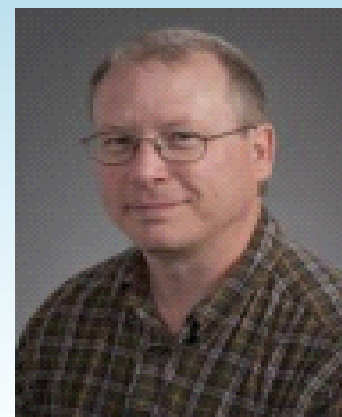
Foxp3, TSLP and the regulation of immunity and inflammation

Background: Dr. Ziegler graduated with honors from the University of Michigan in 1979, and in 1984 received his PhD in molecular biology from UCLA. He is currently Director of the Immunology Program at Benaroya Research Institute, and Affiliate Professor in the Immunology Department, University of Washington School of Medicine.

Areas of Research: The projects in Dr. Ziegler's laboratory are focused on key genes such as Foxp3, and cell populations that are involved in controlling autoimmune-type responses, and the role of novel factor (known as TSLP), that is a key initiator of allergic inflammation.
