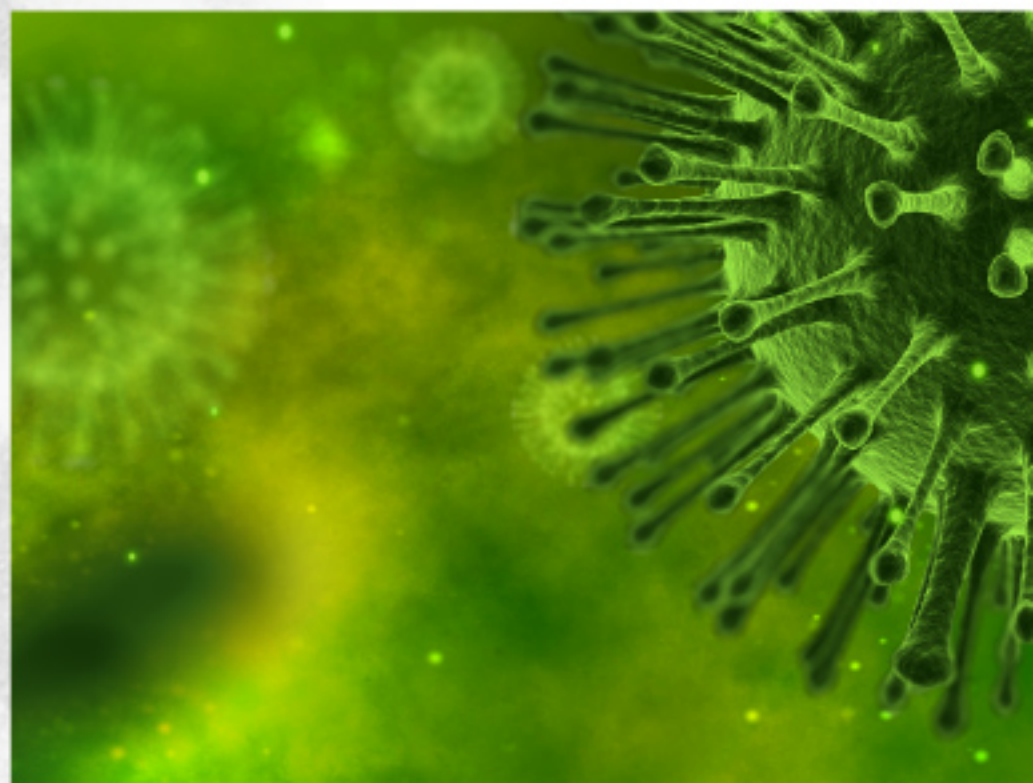


May 13-18, 2013 Shanghai, China

IPS Course on Respiratory Viral Diseases and Tuberculosis

Topics:

The course consists of two parts: theoretical and practical. For theoretical part, 15 internationally renowned scientists will give in-depth lectures on various aspects of respiratory viruses and TB, including epidemiology, pathogen-host interaction, pathogenesis, vaccine, anti-virus and anti-TB. For the practical part, about 20 selected attendants will go through additional three day's in-depth practical training to get hands-on experience in laboratory skills related to respiratory infection, such as pathogen diagnosis with multiplex PCR, antigen detection with antibodies etc.
